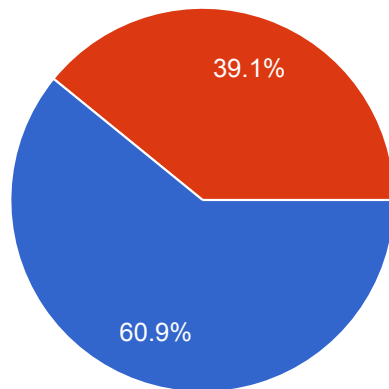

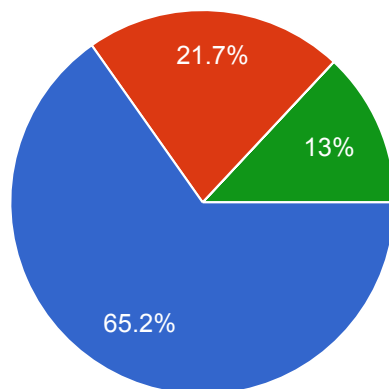


Are you? (23 responses)



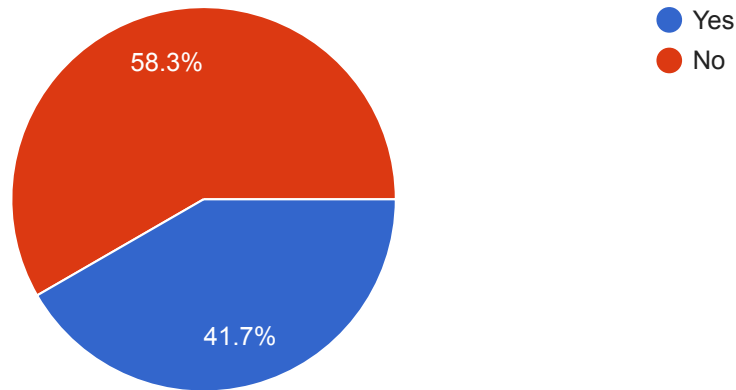

What year are you in? (23 responses)

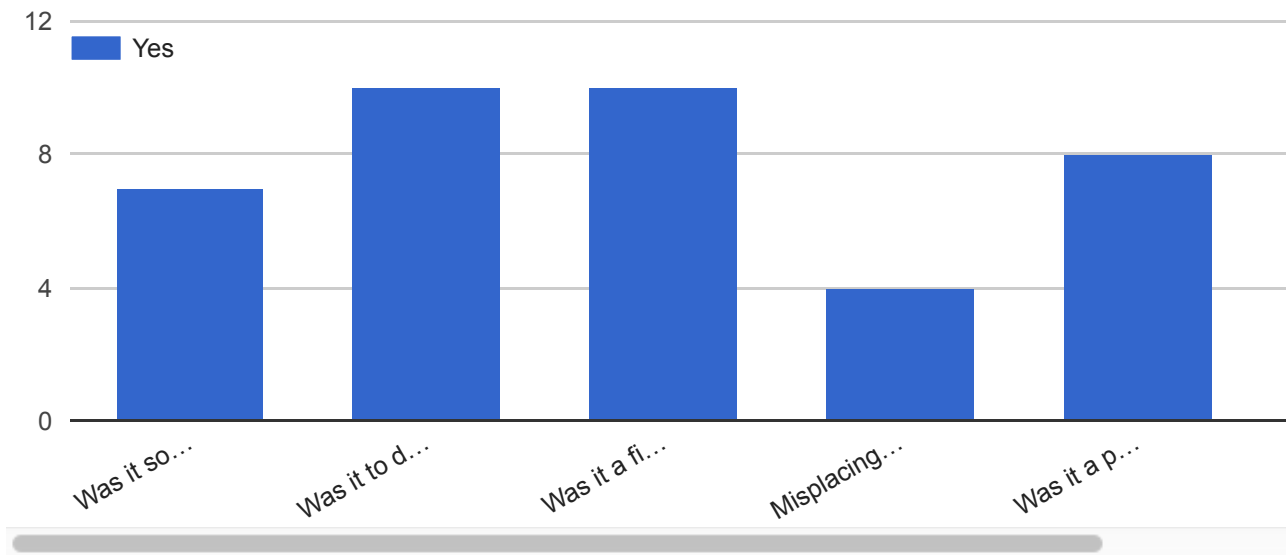

money is the main issue for me at the moment, and it influences everything as taking the bus, eating, buying materials for college cost a lot...

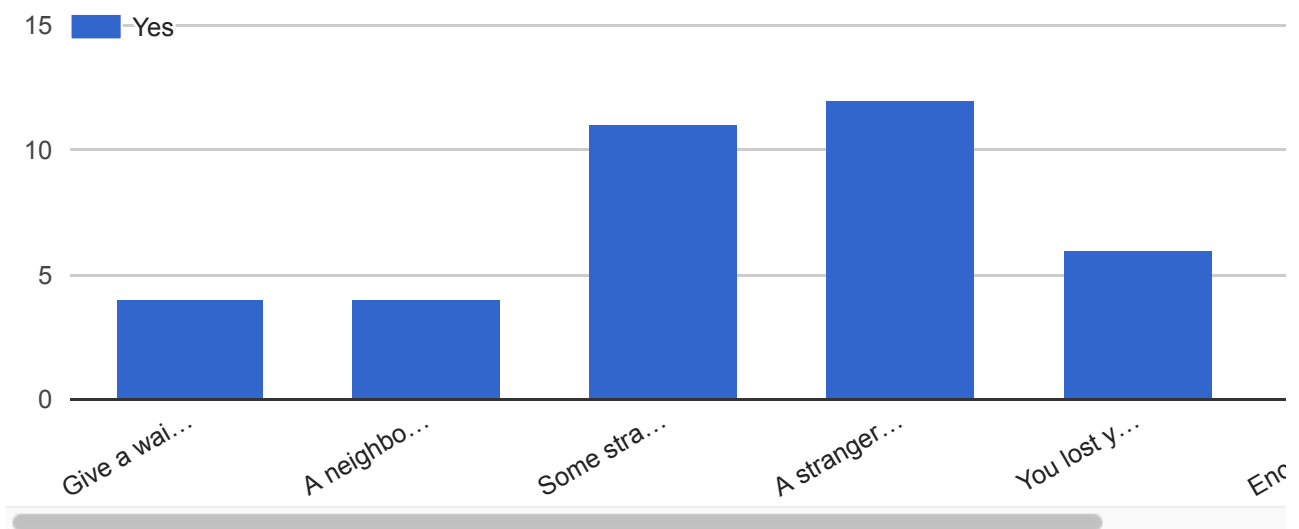
My FYP is driving me mad, so this really cheered me up

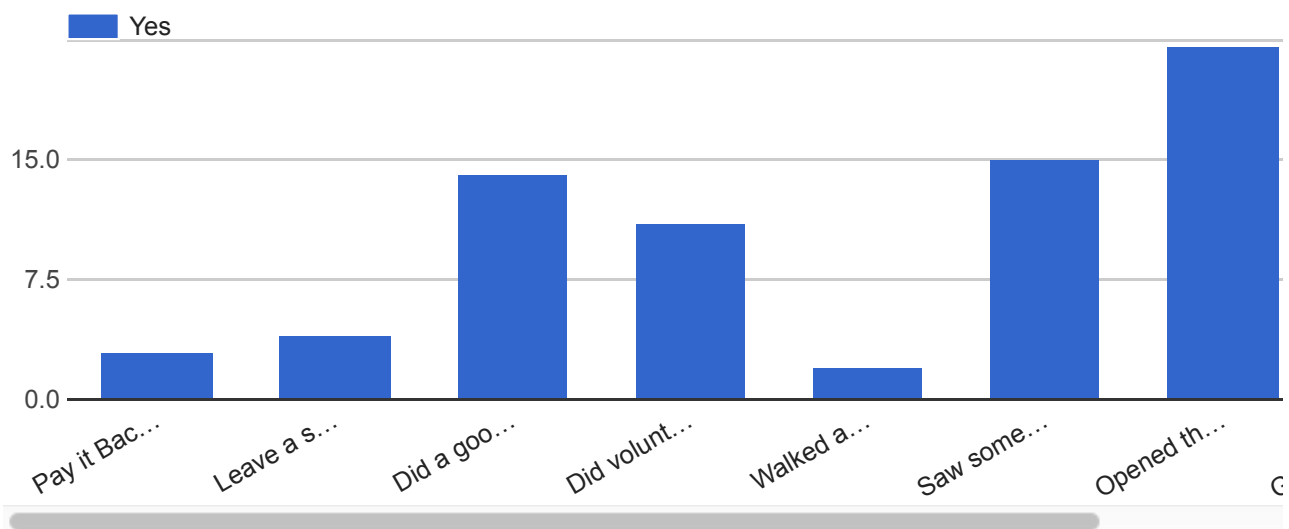

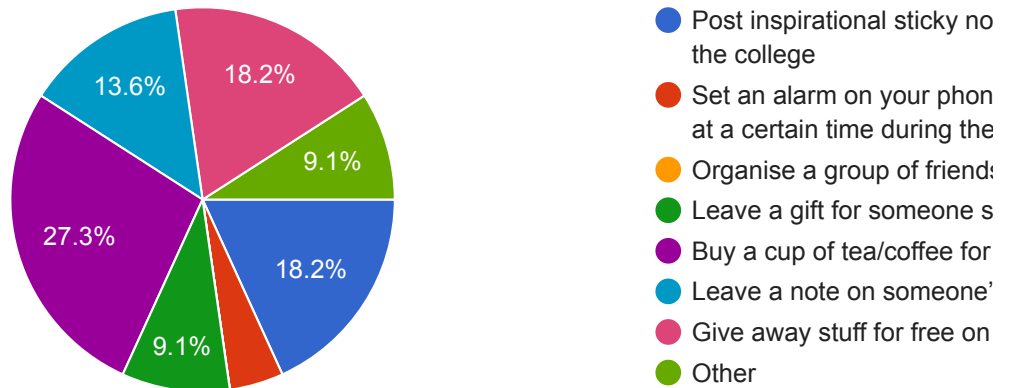
Borrow money to a friend who needed it. Let a friend to stay in my room until she got a place to

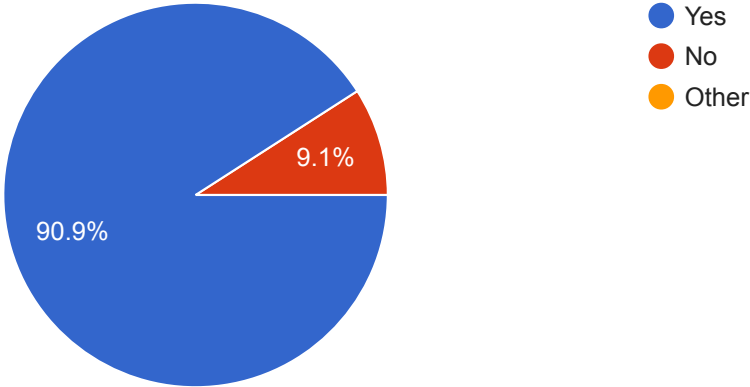
